INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE NEW MEMBERS

Pistol shooting is generally regarded as one of the most challenging forms of the target shooting sports, but it is also one of the most accessible and enjoyable. There are generally no barriers of age, gender or physical disability which will prevent you being an active member of the club, or being able to enjoy the sport and being competitive.

In South Australia, shooting is allowed on club ranges that have been approved by the South Australian Police (SAPOL) only. The Port Augusta Pistol Club Inc. is one such club and has excellent facilities for a country club. We offer shooting of various styles including ISSF, Service Pistol and Black Powder at this time.

Getting involved in the exciting sport of Pistol Shooting is still a fairly straight-forward process. It's an extremely safe and fun activity for all the family. Anyone from the age of 12 can compete. (*Under 18's will require parental consent and supervision*).

WHAT ARE THE STEPS FOR JOINING THE PISTOL CLUB?

Step 1

UNLICENCED PERSON ONLY

- Obtain and complete the form PD 303 - "Application for a Firearms Licence" in person from your local police station.
- You will need to provide identification – 100 points system.
- The Police station will then forward the application to Firearms Branch.

LICENCED PERSON

- Existing licence holders (Categories A,B,C & D) are required to submit the form PD 307 – "Variation / Addition / Revocation of Variation Classes / Purpose of Use Licence Conditions" in person from your local police station.
- You will need to provide identification -100 points system.
- The Police station will then forward the application to Firearms Branch.

Step 2

- Now it is time to obtain and submit the Club's application form/s. These forms should be given to the Club Secretary.
- In approximately 28 days, after the lodgement of the form (either PD 303 or PD 307 you will receive a conformation letter of acceptance from the Firearms Branch together with a blank form PD 314 "Certificate from Accredited Instructor"
- The receipt of this letter and form is the Club instructor's authorisation to proceed with the Fire Arms Safety Awareness Training (FASAT) course. It is imperative that you hand both these documents to the Secretary as soon as possible on receipt of them.

Step 3

- Complete the Fire Arms Safety Awareness Training (FASAT) course.
- After the completion of your Fire Arms Safety Awareness Training (FASAT) course all the forms are to be delivered to the Club Secretary.
- This will then be forwarded to SAPOL Firearms Branch and could take up to 28 days to come back

South Australian Legislation dictates that if a person and was the holder of a shooting club member's licence (Class 'H') and had held the licence for six months or more but less the 12 months then they can only have one of the following:-

1. One .177 calibre air pistol or one .22 calibre rim fire handgun (long rifle or short) or one centre fire handgun
2. One .177 calibre air pistol and one .22 calibre rim fire handgun (long rifle or short)
3. One .177 calibre air pistol and one centre fire handgun

OTHER AFFILIATIONS

As a member of PAPC Inc., you are automatically affiliated with the South Australian Revolver and Pistol Association (SARPA) and Pistol Australia (PA). This allows members to shoot at competitions throughout Australia, at affiliated clubs. Quarterly magazines/bulletins from SARPA and Pistol Australia are part of your membership entitlements. Being a member of SARPA & PA provides a recognised path toward possible State and Australian team selection at National and International competitions.

SAFETY IS PARAMOUNT IN OUR SPORT

Ear Protection

This is one of the most important items a shooter MUST have. Ear protection in the form of earmuffs or at least earplugs should be the first purchase of a shooter. There are many different types that can be purchased from most firearms dealers, or hardware stores. Pre-existing hearing impairment does not exempt you from wearing hearing protection.

Eye Protection

Along with ear protection this is also an essential safety requirement. Even if you do not require spectacles for normal wear you should use protective glasses to guard against eye damage from hot powder or gases. This is especially needed when using any auto loading pistol where there is the added danger of hot cartridge cases flying out of the breech. It is recommended that all shooters and spectators should wear eye protection at all times on any range. Anyone on a range where steel targets are being used must wear eye protection. Special shooting glasses are also available from most reputable firearm dealers.

Dress Code

When ever you shoot, you need, to have certain minimum standards of dress to protect yourself from hot cartridge cases and other range hazards. Sleeved shirts and enclosed footwear is a minimum standard, shorts are acceptable although many people prefer trousers. A hat and/or sunscreen is a good idea especially as shooters spend some time out in the open whilst setting up and scoring their targets. Enclosed footwear is mandatory. (No thongs, sandals or 'open toe' footwear is permitted.) Footwear that supports the ankle is not allowed in ISSF competitions and while this rule is not enforced in club matches it may be enforced in open competitions. *Camouflage style clothing is not acceptable.*

PROSPECTIVE NEW MEMBER JOINING THE PORT AUGUSTA PISTOL CLUB INC. FLOW CHART

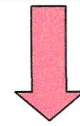
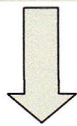
The Club Secretary writes to the Delegate of the Registrar or Firearms requesting a security check.

(Note:- This is required for non-shooting memberships as well)

Prospective new member completes the Application for Membership to join the Club, including the SARPA application for membership and provides contact details for 2 referees, *who have known the prospective new member for more than the immediate past 2 years.*

Approximately 2 – 4 weeks later SAPOL will reply, by letter, to the Club Secretary, confirming or not that the prospective new member has passed the security checks and that they are or not approved to join a Firearms Club.

During this time the Club Secretary will contact the References, to personally ensure the authenticity of the References and to confirm that the Referees consider them a "fit and proper person" to join a Firearms Club.

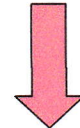
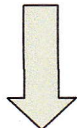

NON 'H' CLASS MEMBERSHIP OF THE CLUB

(Social Membership)

The Club Committee confirms the Application for Membership of the Non 'H' Class (Social) Membership. The Club Secretary then forwards the Application for Membership of SARPA to the SARPA Secretary, with a copy of the SAPOL Letter of Confirmation / Acceptance for approval by SARPA.

HAVE A H1 FIREARMS LICENCE

Firearm regulation 48 - Acceptance of new members

A recognised firearms club must not grant an application for membership of the club unless —

- (c) *the applicant has produced to the club 2 references each of which appears to have been signed by a person within the preceding 21 days and to state that the person has known the applicant for at least the preceding 2 years and that the applicant is a person of good character and a suitable person to be a member of a firearms club; and*
- (d) *an office holder of the club has, by personal contact with the person named in each reference as the referee, confirmed the signing of the reference by the person on the date stated in the reference and the contents of the reference*

Normally will not require permission to start the FASAT Course nor require references from referees, unless the Firearms Instructor deems otherwise.

The Club will appoint a Firearms Instructor who will assess the new member's competency in safety and understanding of the disciplines in which they intend to compete.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENT

If assessed as being safe and competent then completion of *Introduction and *Module 1 to satisfactorily prove competencies in safety standards and the disciplines in which competing in. (*these forms are available from SARPA at no cost)

MAXIMUM REQUIREMENT

If assessed as requiring further safety and match competencies then the full FASAT course will need to be completed, but the letter of Confirmation / Approval will not be required. A SARPA Advice Note will need to be completed to obtain the FASAT pack and the appropriate fee forwarded to SARPA.

SATISFACTORY COMPLETION OF EITHER MINIMUM OR MAXIMUM REQUIREMENTS

The Secretary of the Club will now send to SARPA the Application for Membership to SARPA and the appropriate joining fees and charges are invoiced to you.

3.

HAVE A FIREARMS LICENCE OTHER THAN H1

To add the class H1 to your firearms licence you must complete an Application for a Variation to a Firearms Licence (PD 307) and hand it in at your local Police Station.

Once your letter of Confirmation / Approval has been received it must be handed to the Club Secretary as soon as possible. It is now that the Secretary can send the completed Advice Note and a copy of the Confirmation / Approval letter, along with the fee to SARPA and get the FASAT pack so the course can commence.

PASSING THE FASAT COURSE

The Club Committee confirms the Application for Membership. The Club Secretary then forwards the Application for Membership of SARPA to the SARPA Secretary for approval by SARPA.

FAILING THE FASAT COURSE

FASAT Result Note completed and forwarded to SAPOL and a copy to SARPA
The certificate from Accredited Instructor (PD314) does not need to be completed and the Applicant **cannot re-attempt the FASAT course** for 3 months

To obtain your Firearms Licence you must fill out an Application for a Firearms Licence (PD303) and lodge it at your local Police Station. You will require to produce 100 points of identification at the same time.
